## Student Intern Placements

*From Selected Universities*

Funding to support intern wages. Host tertiary students or recent graduates in meaningful, project-based placements that match your business needs. Engage with high-achieving students from:

- University of Adelaide
- UNSW



## Talent Attraction & Retention

*University/TAFE/Veterans*

Receive financial support to build a stronger workforce by engaging new talent or transitioning existing workforce into longer-term roles. Examples include:

- Hiring or extending roles for individuals from institutions such as UNSW, University of Adelaide, and TAFE, including:
  - Student interns
  - Researchers
  - Postdoctoral fellows (Postdoc)
  - PhD graduates
- Employ Australian Defence Force (ADF) veterans into the defence industry

*Individuals must be already identified.*



## Upskilling & Training

*Your Existing Employees*

Cash support for short courses, certifications, or technical training to build in-demand skills across your team. Funding can help cover all costs associated with training including coursework, travel, accommodation and related expenses. For example:

- Subsidise staff and intern training needs
- Upskill a mid-career professional
- Funding support for staff Defence security clearances
